



# Saginaw County Fair Youth Scholarship

## Eligibility:

- Open to any applicant who has been involved with the Saginaw County Fair as an exhibitor or volunteer for at least 2 years.
- Applicants do not need to be Saginaw County residents.
- Open to any graduating high school senior or a student not out of high school more than one year who intends to pursue further education at a college, university, or trade school.
- Applicants must be under the age of 20 as of January 1 of the year of application.
- Applications will be accepted January 1 - March 30 with awards being announced May 1.
- Applicants cannot be previous recipients of this award.

## Judging Criteria:

- 40% - 2 year minimum involvement with the Saginaw County Fair as an exhibitor or volunteer
- 20% - letter of recommendation from a superintendent, staff member, or volunteer at the Saginaw County Fair
- 20% - written or video essay
- 10% - extra-curricular activities
- 10% - work or volunteer experience
